

# How to sign up to Uber - VIC

In order to provide rideshare services in Victoria, you'll need to apply for a Driver Accreditation at the Commercial Passenger Vehicles Victoria (CPVV).

Check out the steps below on how to get started.

## 1

### Apply for a PTD authorisation

- Complete a medical form and a health questionnaire at your local GP
- You can also choose to do this at the Uber Greenlight Hub in VIC for \$78

## 2

### Complete an online driver accreditation form

- Visit <https://tinyurl.com/y8za3ab4> and fill out the online form to get started
- You will need to select Booked services only
- This costs \$76.30 and the processing can take up to three weeks on average

### Create an Uber account

- If you don't have an Uber account, create one now:

- If you have an Uber Eats account, contact the Uber Support team and advise them that you would like to drive Uber X
- Your Splend sign up specialist will be able to help you upload your documents further down the track

### Complete a VEVO right to work check

- As part of Uber's sign up process, you will need to demonstrate the right to work in Australia
- If you hold either an ① Australian Passport, ② Australian Birth Certificate or ③ Australian Citizenship Certificate, this check will not be conducted
- If you do not hold any of the above documents, you will need to provide one of the following documents in order for this check to be completed in your Uber application: ① Immigration card ② International passport ③ Refugee passport

Congratulations on finishing up all the necessary steps needed to get you driving rideshare and signed up to Uber. Once you receive your confirmation email from Uber, contact your Splend representative for vehicle collection.
