How to sign up to Uber - WA

In order to provide rideshare services in Western Australia you will need to apply for a Passenger Transport Driver (PTD) authorisation. This is an annual authorisation that permits a person to drive a vehicle for hire.

Check out the steps below on how to get started.

Apply for a PTD authorisation

Apply for a PTD authorisation

- You can apply for a PTD authorisation online via your DoTDirect (Department of Transport) account.
- Visit the DoT website here: https://www.transport.wa.gov.au/dotdirect/dotdirect.asp
- This costs \$88 annually and an initial \$28 application fee will need to be paid

Eligible PTD applicants must be:

- Aged 20 years old or more
- Hold a current and valid full WA driver's licence (minimum 1 year) or have held an equivalent driving authorisation from another jurisdiction for at least three years

• Have not been disqualified from holding or obtaining a PTD authorisation

Complete a police check

- Complete a police check at: https://tinyurl.com/y7ctagyl
- This will cost around \$30-\$50
- This needs to be less than three months old when you are applying for your PTD authorisation

Get a medical assessment

- Visit your local GP and complete the medical assessment and fitness to drive form. This is a compulsory health check that you'll need to complete

- \bullet Remember to bring this form with you to your GP for your appointment
- The cost is roughly \$80 depending on your GP
